



FSU is modernizing the process for reporting and approval of faculty and staff outside activity/outside employment, and to identify/manage conflicts of interest within research activities. Disclosures and Pre-Approval requests will be submitted and managed through a new paperless system, known as the **Conflict Administration Management System (CAMS)**.

CAMS will provide the following features and benefits, including but not limited to:

- Automating COI processes and workflow
- Streamlining disclosure forms
- Early flagging of potential conflicts
- Eliminating redundant data input
- Tracking of compliance and improvement of response rates
- Fostering a culture of transparency
- Integration with **RAMP Grants** and **RAMP IRB**

Below are the various disclosure types offered within CAMS based on each user’s assigned discloser group:

Equity	Sponsored Travel
Consulting or Other Professional Services	Board Service
Editorial Services	Outside Employment
Intellectual Property Rights	Other Appointments
Divestiture and Cash Pay-out	Prizes and Honoraria

CAMS will be launched on January 10, 2022. Faculty, staff, and board members will be required to use the new system; however, the point at which users begin using the system will vary.

- Researchers will be prompted to use CAMS in January 2022 based on research activities in RAMP Grants and RAMP IRB
- Staff and board members will disclose within CAMS in January 2022
- Non-research faculty will disclose within CAMS in Fall 2022

How to Access CAMS

There will be three ways to access CAMS once it is live.

- 1) Click on the CAMS icon within the myFSU portal
- 2) Click on the link within an Outlook email notification (which occurs when you need to take action in the system)
- 3) Type the CAMS website address in your internet browser: <https://cams.fsu.edu>
