

Services include but are not limited to crisis counseling, safety planning, emergency housing, referrals to campus and community resources, instructor notification, advocacy through medical or legal procedures, and education on and assistance through Title IX investigations and the student conduct process.


OFFICE OF WITHDRAWAL SERVICES
