## Faculty Orientation <u>2020</u>

The Student Veterans Center coordinates and directs the university's resources and support programs for Florida State students who are veterans, active-duty personnel, Reserve or National Guard members, and military/veteran dependents.

The transition from military service to campus life for these underrepresented students is eased through veteran-specific orientation sessions, a free Strategies for Veteran Success course, and the processing of military and Veterans Affairs educational benefits.

Also central to the SVC's mission is informing and assisting other members of the university community with veteran/military-related issues and policies. The SVC website includes information relevant to <u>FSU faculty members</u> and other instructors, including:

- Policies and procedures for students' short-term military absences and calls to active duty
- The vetting of college credits earned through military training or experience
- Local, state and national resources for active and former military personnel
