FSU is pleased to invite faculty members to utilize the Conflict Administration and Management System (CAMS), beginning on **October 10, 2022**, for completion of annual Outside Activity disclosures and any new Outside Activity opportunities during the year. CAMS modernizes conflict of interest, conflict of commitment, and outside activity disclosures and management through an automated, paperless process that incorporates recent changes to the Collective Bargaining Agreement. General information on the use of the system, including discloser guides, is available on the <u>project website</u>. Users can click on the "Support" tab on the site to view FAQs or complete a support ticket that will go directly to the CAMS team.

On October 10, faculty members will receive an email from CAMS notifying them that their disclosures profiles are ready for update. The email will contain a link that will go directly to the Disclosure Profile Update page, but CAMS is also accessible from the https://www.my.fsu.edu workspace or at https://cams.fsu.edu (FSU logins are required).

If you are a reviewer (Department Chair or Dean), please make every effort to respond promptly to system notifications that you have items for review and approval.
